SkillsUSA Washington Leadership Contest

Purpose

1. To demonstrate the ability of an individual to recite the Creed with knowledge of its meaning.
2. To give an individual the opportunity to memorize, deliver, and answer questions on the SkillsUSA Creed.
3. To give an individual the opportunity to stand before an audience, to develop poise, self-control and ability to be at ease.

Clothing Requirement

The National SkillsUSA Clothing Requirements are used for state contests. No “clothing penalty” points will be assessed providing the contestant is attired “appropriately business-like attire”

Eligibility

Contest is open to properly registered SkillsUSA members.

Required Contest Personnel (3 judges minimum)

1. Lead Judge
2. Timekeeper
3. Student Guides

Scope of the Contest

1. Contestants will demonstrate their ability to recite all the portions of the SkillsUSA Creed.
2. Contestants will be asked 1 to 2 questions, by the judges, on the meaning of the SkillsUSA Creed.

3. The winning contestant will be scored on the basis of:
 - a. Voice
 - b. Stage presence
 - c. Stage presence
 - d. Power of expressions
 - e. Response to questions
 - f. General effect
 - g. Accuracy
4. Contestant will be called by number without mention of name, city or chapter.
5. No contestant is permitted in the assembly until after he/she gives the Creed.

The SkillsUSA Creed

I will, through honesty and fair play, respect the rights of others. I will always conduct myself in the manner of the best professionals in my occupation and treat those with whom I work as I would like to be treated.

I believe satisfaction is achieved by good work

I feel that compensation and personal satisfaction received for my work and services will be in proportion to my creative and productive ability.

I believe in high moral and spiritual standards

I will endeavor to conduct myself in such a manner as to set an example for others by living a wholesome life and by fulfilling my responsibilities as a citizen of my community.
