Register and pay for SLSC at skillsusa-register.org/login.aspx. Invoices will be sent to your school's accounts payable, and payment must be received before travel unless other arrangements are made. A \$100 late fee applies after the due date. Online credit card payments via QuickBooks are the preferred method - no merchant fees.

All registered competitors for SLSC must complete both their technical and professional online tests, which are scored and combined with on-site performance results. Testing is completed at testing.nocti.org, and advisors will receive and distribute testing credentials provided by the state office.

Following SLSC | Virtual All SLSC Scorecards Released

After SLSC, all scorecards will be released for contestants to review their performance rubrics. These are grading rubrics, not true scoring rubrics, and reflect how each contestant performed relative to others in their event. Scorecards will be available approximately one week after the conference at skillsusawashington.org, following the official review period.
