Register for the National Leadership & Skills Conference (NLSC) at [skillsusa-register.org/login.aspx](https://skillsusa-register.org/login.aspx). Advisors must register both students and adults, and book hotel rooms using the link provided in the registration system. Invoices will be sent via QuickBooks from state staff. A \$100 late fee applies after the due date. Late fees are incurred bi-weekly post conference. Online credit card payments via QuickBooks are the preferred method - no merchant fees.

Do not use the online fee estimate. On-site registration will also be available after the SLSC awards session.

Pricing: **\$600** per student/advisor + **\$350**/hotel room night.

### Following SLSC | Virtual All SLSC Scorecards Released

After SLSC, all scorecards will be released for contestants to review their performance rubrics. These are grading rubrics, not true scoring rubrics, and reflect how each contestant performed relative to others in their event. Scorecards will be available approximately one week after the conference at [skillsusawashington.org](https://skillsusawashington.org), following the official review period.
